As you may be aware, our theme in Year Four this term is “Crime and Punishment Throughout the Ages”. Trips and visits are a great way to bring the curriculum to life and generate a great deal of excitement and engagement in a topic. We would travel by coach and get dropped off and collected close to the Tower. We will spend the day exploring the Tower and take part in an educational workshop that focuses on crime and punishment throughout the ages.
