Dear Year 3 Parents,

Chiltern Open Air Museum – ‘Wolf Brother’ Literacy themed day

On **Thursday 4th May**, in connection with our “Stone Age” topic, we have arranged a trip for Year 3 to visit Celtic Open Air Museum, where we will be participating in ‘Wolf Brother’ Literacy themed day.

The cost per child will be £15.35, which includes the admission charges for Chiltern Open Air Museum and the cost of the coach.

During the day children will:

- Meet with the Deer Mage in his secret camp and create a totem to protect themselves against the huge evil, killer bear who is hunting Torak.
- Meet with a Stone Age hunter who will show the high value and significance placed on each part of an animal.
- Either create a Stone Age replica weapon or create a journey stick as you travel through our grounds and woodland following the steps of Torak’s wolf cub and his ‘wolf speak’ descriptions.

They will be required to wear their own clothes. As we will be in wooded area, please could the clothes they wear be ideal for this sort of outdoor activity.

All children will require a packed lunch and drink(s) for this trip, which they will carry with them all day. Please do not send your child with any canned or fizzy drinks.

We also need a small number of adult helpers, so if you are able to assist on the day, please notify us via School Gateway if you are available to help.

Children will need to be at school promptly at **8.30am** on this day and will be back by about 3.15pm for the end of the school day.

Parental consent and payment is now requested using School Gateway. www.schoolgateway.com. This needs to be completed by Friday 28th April.

Payment for activities taking place during the school day are considered a voluntary contribution, however, we must emphasise that if all parents do not contribute this amount, the trip may not be able to go ahead.
