<p>Anglo-Saxons</p> <p>History – Children will explore the everyday lives of the Anglo-Saxon people, including religion and the Anglo-Saxon culture.</p> <p>Geography – Children will explore types of settlements and land use.</p> <p>DT – Children will design and create an Anglo-Saxon village.</p>	<p>Traditional Tales – Study of the story of Beowulf.</p> <p>Narrative Poetry – Read and recite some narrative poetry.</p> <p>Plays-Write and perform a play, based on a familiar story.</p> <p>Take One Book Week – Whole school text to be covered.</p>	<p>Number and place value – Larger numbers, to include fractions and decimals.</p> <p>Statistics – Presenting and interpreting discrete and continuous data.</p> <p>Addition and subtraction – Numbers up to 4 digits, including decimals.</p> <p>Measurement – Converting between different units of measurement.</p> <p>Multiplication and division – Mental and written methods up to 12x12.</p> <p>Fractions – Comparing and ordering.</p>
