Dear Year 1 Parents,

## Hudnall Park

On **Thursday 23rd March**, in connection with Year 1's topic of "Inventors and Explorers", we have arranged a very exciting trip for Year 1 to visit Hudnall Park, where we will be exploring a dragon themed exploring day, creating dragon homes and potions in the forest!

The cost per child will be £14.75, which includes workshop fees and transport.

On the day the children should wear several layers of warm clothing, and a waterproof coat with appropriate outdoor footwear (wellies or trainers). They will also be required to bring some clean indoor shoes (in a plastic bag, that they can put their "possible" muddy wellies/trainers in for the journey home) as we will be inside and outside during the day.

All children will require a healthy packed lunch and drink(s) for this trip, in a small ruck sack, which they will carry with them all day. Please not send your child with any canned or fizzy drinks.

If you would prefer school to supply a school packed lunch for this trip, we can do this, as a part of UiFSM. **Please enter UiFSM on School Gateway in the comments section before Friday 10<sup>th</sup> March, as we will need to order the food in advance from Herts Catering. After this date, you will be required to provide a packed lunch for the trip.**

We will also need a small number of adult helpers. If you would like to help on this trip, please speak to your class teacher. We are only able to take a certain number of parent helpers, due to ratios required and seats on the coach.

Children will need to be at school no later than 8.45am on this day and we will be back by normal pick up time.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please also notify us prior to the trip as medication forms need to be completed prior to the trip. Travel sickness medication must come in its' original packaging with dosing amount. Forms are available from the school office.

**Parental consent and payment is now requested using School Gateway [www.schoolgateway.com](http://www.schoolgateway.com). This needs to be completed by Friday 10th March.**

Payment for activities taking place during the school day are considered a voluntary contribution, however, we must emphasise that if all parents do not contribute this amount, the trip may not be able to go ahead.
