## Hatfield House - Hatfield

On **Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July**, in connection with our Henry VIII – Tudor History topic, we have arranged a trip for Year 3 to visit Hatfield House, where we will be participating in a Henry VIII, Tudor Themed day.

The cost per child will be £13.30, which includes the admission charges for Hatfield House, cost of the coach and participation in the Living History Programme that has been organised for us.

To enhance the Tudor experience we would like to go in costume – a tabard over their school uniform is sufficient but you are welcome to make their costume as authentic as you like! **Instructions on how to make a tabard are included and this is part of their home learning for the summer term. Please can the tabard be in school by Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June for them to decorate at school.**

All children will require a packed lunch and drink(s) for this trip, which they will carry with them all day. Please do not send your child with any canned or fizzy drinks.

Children will need to be at school promptly at **8.40am** on this day and will be back in time for normal school pick up.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please also notify us prior to the trip as medication forms need to be completed prior to the trip. Travel sickness medication must come in its' original packaging with dosing amount. Forms are available from the school office.

Payment for activities taking place during the school day are considered a voluntary contribution, however, we must emphasise that if all parents do not contribute this amount, the trip may not be able to go ahead.
