Dear Year 4 Parents,

Thank you for responding to our letter regarding permission to travel.

On **Tuesday 11th July**, we have arranged an exciting trip to the Tower of London to enhance our topic for year 4 for this term of "Crime and Punishment throughout the Ages". We will also be participating in a "Crime at the Tower" workshop.

The cost per child will be £20.85, which includes the entrance fees to the Tower of London, workshop fees, and insurance and transportation costs.

Children will need to be at school promptly at **8.00am** on this day and we are due to return later than normal school pick up time. We anticipate we will be back by about **3.45pm** on this day, depending on the return journey traffic from London. Children should be collected from their usual classroom after the trip.

All children will need to wear school uniform for this trip and bring along a waterproof coat, snack, packed lunch, drink and water bottle, in a small rucksack. Please do not send canned or fizzy drinks. No pocket money is required.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please also notify us prior to the trip as medication forms need to be completed prior to the trip. Travel sickness medication must come in its' original packaging with dosing amount. Forms are available from the school office.

Parental consent and payment is now requested using SchoolGateway. www.schoolgateway.com. This needs to be completed by Wednesday 28th June.

Payment for activities taking place during the school day are considered a voluntary contribution, however, we must emphasise that if all parents do not contribute this amount, the trip may not be able to go ahead. In cases of financial difficulty, please contact Mrs Wheeler to discuss payments.
