Dear Year 5 Parents,

The London Transport Museum – London

On **Thursday 6th July**, in connection with our “Travelling through Time” theme, we have arranged a very exciting trip for Year 5 to visit the London Transport Museum and also attend an inspiring engineering workshop on how engines and vehicles work and how this has changed over time.

The cost per child will be **£12.00**, which includes the inspiring engineering workshop, and transportation.

Children will need to be at school promptly at **8.00am** on this day and we are due to return later than normal school pick up time. We anticipate we will be back by about **3.45pm** on this day, depending on the return journey traffic from London. Children should be collected from their usual classroom after the trip.

All children will need to wear school uniform for this trip and bring along a waterproof coat, snack, packed lunch, drink and water bottle, in a small rucksack. Please do not send canned or fizzy drinks. No pocket money is required.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please also notify us prior to the trip as medication forms need to be completed prior to the trip. Travel sickness medication must come in its' original packaging with dosing amount. Forms are available from the school office.

We also need a small number of adult helpers, so if you are able to assist on the day, please see your class teacher.

Parental consent and payment is now requested using School Gateway. www.schoolgateway.com This needs to be completed by Wednesday 28th June.

Payment for activities taking place during the school day are considered a voluntary contribution, however, we must emphasise that if all parents do not contribute this amount, the trip may not be able to go ahead. In cases of financial difficulty, please contact Mrs Wheeler to discuss payments.
