<u>Our main theme: 'Building Societies'</u>	<u>English units:</u>	<u>Maths topics:</u>
<p>History – Children will explore the history of the Mayan Civilisation.</p> <p>Geography – Children will locate and compare different continents and oceans across the world.</p> <p>DT – Children will explore yarns, threads and weaving techniques to design and weave a Mayan belt.</p> <p>Art – children will use clay techniques to design and create a tile to represent a Mayan event.</p> <p>Computing – Children will be exploring spreadsheets and computer networks.</p> <p>RE – Children will learn about Hinduism and importance of Christmas for Christians.</p> <p>Music – Children will explore rhythmic patterns and create a class orchestra.</p> <p>Science – Children will compare and classify different types of animals and plants. Also, children will learn about the human body, particularly the digestion system.</p>	<p>Riddles – Children will explore and write their own riddles.</p> <p>Story settings – Children will look at a range of settings and write their own descriptions.</p> <p>Persuasion – Children will be writing their own persuasive texts.</p> <p>Free Verse Poetry – Creating poems without rhyme or rhythm.</p> <p>Reports – Children will be writing their own reports about the Mayans.</p>	<p>Number and place value – comparing number systems from history to ours. Also, children will learn to round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1,000.</p> <p>Multiplication and division – Mental methods up to 12x12.</p> <p>Addition and Subtraction – add and subtract numbers formally up to four digits.</p> <p>Statistics – Presenting and interpreting data.</p> <p>Measurement – measure and calculate perimeter.</p> <p>Geometry – exploring 2D shapes (particularly types of triangles and quadrilaterals) and symmetry.</p>
