<u>Our main theme:</u>	<u>English units:</u>	<u>Maths topics:</u>
<p>Fact or Fiction?</p> <p>We will be focusing on the historical and current geographical features of Greece. As well as understanding the contributions Ancient Greeks made to life today. Alongside this, we will be looking at Greek pottery and creating pieces of art in this style.</p> <p>In Science, the children will be looking at the Earth, Sun and Moon along with forces.</p> <p>In Computing, the children will be creating a stop animation film linked to our theme using story boarding and combining still images to create a sequence.</p>	<p>This term the children will read and extend the poem 'The Highwayman'. They will be learning about a range of poetic features that this classic narrative poem contains.</p> <p>They will also be reading and writing detailed instructions. Linked to our theme, the children will be reading and writing Greek Myths.</p> <p>Throughout all of these English units, the children will be improving their grammatical understanding, spelling and handwriting.</p>	<p>We will be looking at broadening and deepening the children's knowledge of multiplication and division.</p> <p>Also, the children will be looking at the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages. They will be learning how to compare, order, add and subtract fractions.</p> <p>Following on from this, the children will be developing their understanding of measures by comparing metric and imperial measures and converting other units of measure.</p> <p>Throughout all of these units, children will need to apply their understanding of the four operations.</p>
